SB2131 Briggs R. **ENVIRONMENT & NATURE: Prohibits establishments from providing carryout bags.** Prohibits grocery stores, retail stores, and food service establishments from providing a carryout bag, defined as a bag made of paper or plastic meant for a single use, to a customer. Broadly captioned.

12. SB2521 Briggs R. **ENVIRONMENT & NATURE:** Requires rules for recovered materials processing facilities Requires the commissioner of environment and conservation to establish rules to create a permanent process for owners and operators of recovered material processing facilities. Requires the permitting process to mirror those under the Tennessee Solid Waste Disposal Act and to include the creation of a permit fee, schedule of fines and provisions ensuring that the facilities operate according to the law.
