HB46 Lamar L. **EDUCATION: Changes requirements in testing drinking water in public schools.** Requires the department of education develop a water testing program to reduce potential lead contamination in drinking water in public schools instead of boards of education. Requires child care programs to implement the water testing program required for public schools. Changes the lead level that requires a school or child care program take certain steps under the program 20 to 15 parts per billion. **Fiscal Note:** (Dated February 5, 2021) NOT SIGNIFICANT SB1410 - R. HB91 Lamberth W. **PUBLIC FINANCE: Time frame within which loans from the drinking water revolving loan fund must be amortized.** Increases from 20 to 30 years the amount of time within which loans from the drinking water revolving loan fund must be amortized.
